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### RULES AND OTHER GOVERNING PROVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS – GENERAL

# **ITEM 1** [A]

### **CANCELLATION NOTICE**

FT CSP 6004-A cancels FT 6004 in its entirety.

Provisions formerly published in FT CSP 6004 and not brought forward in FT CSP 6004-A are hereby canceled.

### **ITEM 10**

### STATION LISTS AND CONDITIONS

This publication is governed by the Official Railroad Station List, OPSL 6000–series, issued by RAILINC, Agent.

#### **ITEM 20**

#### REFERENCE TO TARIFFS, ITEMS, NOTES, RULES

Where reference is made in this tariff to tariffs, items, notes, rules, circulars, etc., such references are continuous and include supplements to and successive issues of such tariffs, and reissues of such items, notes, rules, circulars, etc.

### **ITEM 30**

### **METHOD OF CANCELLING ITEMS**

As this tariff is supplemented, numbered items with lettered suffixes cancel correspondingly numbered items in the original tariff or in a prior supplement. Letter suffixes will be used in alphabetical sequences starting with A. For example: Item 100-A cancels Item 100 and Item 200-B cancels Item 200-A in a prior supplement, which in turn cancelled Item 200.

### RULES AND OTHER GOVERNING PROVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS – UNLIMITED

#### **ITEM 75**

### **CARS HELD FOR PAYMENT**

Cars held for payment of freight or accessorial charges will accrue demurrage charges at the same rate as normal demurrage charges. However, no free time will be granted.

#### **ITEM 80**

### CARS HELD FOR SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

Cars held for shipping instructions will accrue demurrage charges at the same rate as normal demurrage charges. However, no free time will be granted.

#### **ITEM 90**

### **CARS HELD FOR LOAD ADJUSTMENT**

Cars held for the adjustment of lading will accrue demurrage charges at the same rate as normal demurrage charges. However, no free time will be granted.

### **INVOICE DISPUTE PROCEDURES**

In the event that a Customer disputes any charges incurred, the following procedures must be applied:

- A. A dispute to an invoice must be submitted within ten (10) calendar days from the date of the invoice. If a dispute is not received within this time, the bill will be considered correct and must be paid.
- B. A dispute to an invoice must be submitted on CSP's online Customer Dispute form at: <a href="https://form.jotform.com/91756129015154">https://form.jotform.com/91756129015154</a>, and a CSP Accounting Representative will contact you.
- C. Amounts in dispute will not be considered past due until ten (10) days after the dispute resolution is concluded by CSP.
- D. Disputes received after the ten (10) day provision will be subject to a \$200.00 research fee.

### **ITEM 95.2**

### **COLLECTION OF CHARGES**

All charges are due in US currency within 15 days of invoice date. All invoices are subject to a 3% per month finance charge if unpaid within 30 days from the date of invoice. In the event of a dispute, shippers shall provide written notice within 30 days from the date of the bill, specifying the bill number and the basis for the dispute. Customers responsible for original charges shall also be responsible for all additional collection costs, including attorney fees and court costs, if CSP is required to collect in this manner. CSP may at its sole discretion require prepayment of services.

Customers may remit charges to CSP via electronic methods; however, customer shall bear all related charges assessed by customer's financial institutions. Electronic remittances will be made in conformance with instructions provided by CSP.

Customers will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge or the maximum allowed by law on all checks returned unpaid by customer's financial institution for nonsufficient or uncollected funds. Additionally, interest charges, as described in this item, will be assessed if returned check results in charges collected by CSP outside of credit terms.

CSP shall not accept responsibility for failure by customer to provide purchase order numbers or similar customer internal documentation authorizing CSP to provide services. CSP shall attempt to provide customer with information used in customer's internal accounting processes but inability to provide requested information or the inability to comply with customer's internal documentation procedures will in no way remove customer's obligation to pay charges within credit terms assessed pursuant to applicable tariffs or contracts.

### SECTION 1 DEMURRAGE RULES AND CHARGES

### **ITEM 100**

## CARS SUBJECT TO DEMURRAGE RULES AND CHARGES

(See Exception)

Railroad, railroad-controlled, and private cars held for or by consignees (See Note 1) and consignors (See Note 2) for any purpose are subject to the demurrage rules and charges described in this tariff. All cars of TTX Company will be considered railroad-controlled equipment.

- Note 1 For the purpose of applying the provision of Section 1, this tariff, Consignee includes any person receiving railcars from this railroad for unloading as more specifically provided for in 49 CFR 1333.
- Note 2 For the purpose of applying the provision of Section 1, this tariff, Consignor includes any person receiving railcars from this railroad for loading as more specifically provided for in 49 CFR 1333.

Exception: Demurrage rules and charges contained herein will not apply to empty or loaded private cars held on private tracks.

### **FREE TIME**

Free time will be allowed for each car as follows:

- Free time, where provided (See Item 140), will begin the first midnight following actual or constructive placement.
- For the purpose of computing free time, Sundays and Holidays will be excluded, provided that a chargeable day has not occurred prior to the Sunday or holiday.

Chargeable days are defined as days, or portions thereof, that follow the expiration of free time as described in Item 120.

Note: On shipper owned or leased rail cars, after expiration of free time where provided, charges will apply from time of constructive placement until actual placement.

#### **ITEM 150**

### **DEMURRAGE LIABILITY**

Any person or entity receiving rail cars from this railroad for loading or unloading who detains the cars beyond the period of free time set forth herein will be held liable for any applicable demurrage if this railroad has provided that person or entity with actual notice of the demurrage rules and charges contained herein providing for such liability prior to the placement of rail cars. The notice shall be in written or electronic form.

### SECTION 2 STORAGE RULES AND CHARGES

### **CONDITIONS OF STORAGE**

CSP will accept private cars for storage on CSP tracks on the conditions listed herein and all other applicable tariffs. Cars will be stored subject to track availability. Customer, at customer's sole expense, shall provide CSP a certificate of insurance coverage certifying the existence of \$2,000,000 of general liability insurance coverage.

### **ITEM 210**

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# STORAGE CHARGES ON PRIVATE CARS AND FOREIGN LOCOMOTIVES

(See Note)

### I - PRIVATE CARS

Private cars, loaded or empty, held on CSP storage/hold tracks at customer request, will be subject to a storage hold charges per car per day, or fraction thereof, as shown below, computed from the time car is first held until car is released from storage hold:

- (a) Non-Hazardous Cars...\$50.00
- (b) Hazardous Cars...... \$65.00

### **II - FOREIGN LOCOMOTIVES**

Foreign Locomotives held on CSP storage/hold tracks awaiting disposition instructions will be subject to a storage hold charge of \$500.00 per locomotive per day, or fraction thereof, computed from the time locomotive is first held until locomotive is released from storage hold.

Note: This railroad does not assume liability beyond reasonable and ordinary care while cars or locomotives are stored/held on storage/hold tracks of this railroad, or for loss or damage caused by an Act of God, vandalism or theft. In the event full liability coverage is desired, cost of such coverage will be the responsibility of the customer or owner.

Charges shown below with be assessed per car for cars switched into and out of storage. The charges will be assessed in each direction.

### **REPOSITIONING CARS**

When a customer requests removal of specific car(s) from storage which requires this railroad to sort and reposition other cars at the customer's request, a charge of \$650.00 per car, per occurrence, will be assessed to the customer making the request. These charges are in addition to the outbound switch charge.
